#### Cross country ski taster trip



When time is of the essence, or you're not quite sure about a whole week devoted to an activity you've never tried before...why not try our short taster trip? Short travel distance from the airport, learn to cross country ski, pull a pulk, set up a tent in winter conditions, and sleep out in a tent for a night. Try it and see for yourself ©

#### Winter Polar Training Course



Winter in Norway is simply fantastic, with 2-3 metres of snow and magical light. Join us high up in the Norwegian mountains around Gaustatoppen for this introductory course to learn the skills you need to enjoy the mountains safely, learn to ski, pull a pulk, make emergency survival, shelters, and sleep out for 3 nights in a tent – a great starting point for your first polar expedition.

### Ski technique training course



Reached a plateau with your ability to get down a steep slope without your pulk taking you out, or find that you're taking twice as many steps as you need because your skis aren't gliding so well? Skills learing can improve so much quicker with some bespoke training and tuition. Overnight accommodation indoors, so you can focus on the skiing!

#### **Crossing Norway**



This 'classic' adventure, skiing from just inside the Swedish border to the Norwegian west coast, covers 70km of mountainous scenery in the Trøndelag region at 63 degrees north. A very varied ski expedition through the Sylan mountains.

It could also be called 'To Hell and back...' – the name of the place where we start and finish!

#### Hardangervidda North



Refresh your cross country polar skills whilst skiing from the tiny settlement of Haugastøl to Geilo over the northern edge of this 'classic' high arctic plateau. Our journey covers 50km of mountainous scenery, skiing an average distance of 12km per day over 4.5 days - a great 'next step' to consolidate skills before longer more remote trips and expeditions.

# Hardangervidda Crossing



A committing journey travelling 115km in 7.5 days of skiing over the high arctic plateau of the Hardanger – famous for its links with the WW2 Heroes of Telemark, and used as a training ground by Amundsen before his expedition to the South Pole. (also known for its challenging weather!). A great journey which will quickly develop efficient polar routines.

### Rondane hut to hut trip



Skiing above the tree line in the Rondane Norwegian mountains - this trip is ideally suited to those who are keen to learn to pull a lightweight pulk with everything they need to 'overnight indoors' at a variety of mountain lodges and hyttes – plenty of time to find out about the Norwegian hytte system...and to stop off to eat waffles en route!

# Skarvheimen Easter adventure



If you've already done some ski trips and simply want to spend time soaking up the stunning Norwegian mountain scenery of Skarvheimen (north from Finse), we stay at DNT Geiterygghytte.
