Ski technique training



Reached a plateau with your ability - getting down a steep slope without your pulk taking you out, or find that you're taking twice as many steps as you need because your skis aren't gliding so well? Keen to learn more about winter navigation, or polar race preparation? Skills learning can improve so much quicker with some bespoke training and tuition.

Polar training refresher



Already able to cross country ski, yet you need the experience of learning the tricks and tips for polar camping and skiing with a pulk? Is it a few years since you put on skis and camped out, and looking for a refresher? This training will serve as a gateway to learn the skills for participating in our more remote polar trips, where there is no 'indoor option' when 'on tour'.

Winter Polar training



Winter in Norway is simply fantastic, with 2-3 metres of snow and magical light. Join us high up in the Norwegian mountains around Hemsedal for this introductory course to learn the skills you need to enjoy the mountains safely, learn to ski, pull a pulk, make emergency snowshelters, and sleep out for 3 nights in a tent – a great starting point for your first polar expedition.

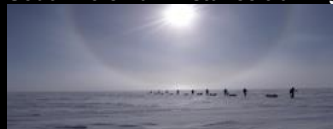
South Pole (guided) training



This 9 day winter polar training course is specifically aimed at those preparing towards a future guided ski expedition to the geographic South Pole with our preferred Antarctic provider – Antarctic Logistics & Expeditions (ALE). It also covers the 'first stage' of preparation for those going on to participate in a full distance guided ski expedition to the South Pole.

South Pole Full Distance training



We are very well acquainted with the conditions and skills to be able to succeed skiing to the South Pole. All previous individuals and groups we have trained, have reached their objective. In addition to the 9 day course, this training will enable you to consolidate your experience needed before undertaking a guided full distance South Pole ski expedition with our preferred Antarctic provider - ALE.

Skarvheimen hut to hut tour



Skiing high up in the Skarvheimen Norwegian mountains north of Finse, this journey covers between 12-16km each day. We ski with lightweight pulks, and stay 'overnight indoors' at a variety of mountain hyttes. There will be plenty of opportunities along the way, to improve your ski technique, especially on the downhill! Ideal for those who already have some cross country ski experience.

Hardangervidda Crossing



A committing journey travelling 100km over the high arctic plateau of the Hardanger, from Haugastøl on the northern edge to Rjukan in the south – this is an area famous for its links with the WW2 Heroes of Telemark, and used as a training ground by Amundsen before his expedition to the South Pole. A great journey which will quickly develop efficient polar routines.

Svalbard crossing on skis



Wild and magnificent – this is untouched Svalbard beyond the snowmobile tracks, trails and traditional tourist routes. Polar bears have been spotted on several previous trips. A perfect 8 day ski trip for exploring the east coast, or for those simply wanting to discover more about Svalbard history and glaciology.

Svalbard multi-activity



Intrigued by this high arctic archipelago - the closest habitation to the North Pole? Are you a beginner on cross country skis and ski touring equipment, or first time hiking and dog-sledding in the polar environment? Beware - these experiences will likely affect you with a lifetime desire to keep returning to fulfill your 'polar bug'.

Svalbard hiking



24 hours daylight and long comparatively warm summer days, our hiking day trips take in journeys to the top of the mountains above the town of Longyearbyen, and other options further out of town. It will be a true remote and wild adventure, each day exploring this dramatic high Arctic polar landscape.

Svalbard Cross country skiing



Our cross country skiing day trip programme is specifically aimed at those who already have some experience on these kind of skis, and are keen to explore the glaciers and valleys of Svalbard, whilst enjoying their accommodation 'indoors' each night! Each day is designed to give a different polar ski opportunity over these few days.

Randonee – Norway



This is our introductory course to randonee (ski touring). We aim to provide the best technical training available, taking you from the first few days spent on pisted practice slopes, to mountain day trips skiing out from our basecamp, where we overnight for 3 days.

Randonee advanced – Svalbard



Now you have the ski touring skills to go further, steeper, and more remote. Put your randonee skills into practice in Svalbard – the high arctic wilderness gem. From day trips near to 'town' to refresh our skills, we then head further out for more day trip adventures accessed by snowmobiles.

North Pole Last Degree ski



The North Pole has it all with pressure ridges, open water, and a labyrinth of ice and snow that forms a magical scenery where the sun never sets. This is a 10-day ski adventure for the true explorer with the same food, equipment, and polar routines as a full crossing of the Polar Ocean.

Crossing Greenland



Crossing Greenland on skis is one of the most beautiful, but physically demanding, ski journeys. 560km pulling a sledge weighing 60 kg requires good preparations, and training.
